Kingston Catholic School Extended Day Program

The extended day program is held on each regularly scheduled school day from 3:00-6:00 p.m. On the half days the program runs from 12:20-6:00 p.m.

The weekly sign-up sheet for the program will specify the days your child(ren) will attend and the pick-up time each day. The sign-up sheet will be posted on the website on Wednesday under "weekly envelope". In order for your child to be given a space in the following week's program, the envelope must be returned to school by Friday. Payment must accompany all requests for program use. As the number of spaces available is limited, fees paid to the program are nonrefundable and nontransferable, even if your child does not attend on a day that you reserved a space. (The only exceptions are snow days and early closings.)

An emergency card will be kept on file with the Extended Day Program separate from the school's records. Please be sure that emergency phone numbers enable us to reach someone at all times.

An annual non-refundable registration fee of \$20.00 per family is required. The fee schedule for the Extended Day Program is as follows:

1 Child Additional Children
\$15.00 per day \$13.00 per day each additional child
\$65.00 per week (2) \$110/week (3) \$150/ week (4) \$160/week
\$80.00 per week w/a Half Day
\$30.00 Half Day only (2)\$55 (3)\$80 (4) \$105

Late pick up fee: Families arriving after 6:00 p.m. will be billed an additional \$25.00 per half hour.

Extended Day activities will include snack time, outdoor playtime, indoor games, use of computer lab, gym and library, arts and crafts, story time and more. An opportunity for quiet study and homework will be provided. The Extended Day Program staff cannot guarantee homework completion.

Students must provide their own snack daily, as well as lunch and snack on First Fridays. "Play clothes" are the most practical choice for our program. Students in grades K-8 may bring a change of clothes if they wish. Pre-K students do not need to change.

Pick up for the Extended Day Program is at the back doors of the school. Parking is available in the back parking lot. We ask that you enter the lot with care and watch for children, as we are frequently "at play" there.

As stated above, payment is made in advance to the main office by Friday of the previous week with envelopes marked KCS Extended Day Program. Checks are made payable to Kingston Catholic School.

Before care is available Monday through Friday starting at 7:30am. The fee is \$15 for the week regardless of how many days are needed.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Although we may not realize it, asbestos is a common material in almost every building in our society. It is a fireproofing material; it is found in floor tiles; it is used as an acoustical material to deaden sound. Under certain conditions, however, when it is damaged, asbestos can prove to be a concern.

Because of this concern, the Federal Government asks every school in the country to conduct an inspection for all asbestos-containing materials.

The inspection of our school is done annually. It reveals asbestos-containing materials in the floor, boiler room and some insulated pipes. "It is," as the Environmental Protection Agency states, "important to note that not all friable asbestos-containing material need be removed from the schools." One such material has been identified; a program can be implemented to insure that the material is maintained in good condition, and that appropriate precautions are followed when the material is disturbed for any reason.

Every year the Archdiocese sends an inspector to check conditions in our school. Once again, Kingston Catholic School is in compliance with all state regulations and safety conditions. Each year it is my duty to report this to you. Thank you.
