



Alison Chace is a freelance violinist and private violin and viola teacher in the Hudson Valley. She received her Bachelor of Music in Music Education with a Performance Certificate in violin from the University of South Carolina. She has studied with Dr. Jacob Dakon (University of Kansas), Dr. Nancy Bargerstock (Appalachian State University), and Dr. William Terwilliger (University of South Carolina).

Ms. Chace is a member of the Greater Newburgh Symphony Orchestra, Northern Dutchess Symphony, Woodstock Symphony Orchestra, and the Catskill String Quartet and frequently serves in leadership positions for these orchestras. Ms. Chace also serves as an on-call violinist/violist for other orchestras and chamber groups in the area, and plays for many different churches and schools around the Hudson Valley. The greatest honor so far of her career has been playing in the orchestra with Christian singer-songwriter Steven Curtis Chapman at Carnegie Hall in February 201.

Ms. Chace started her teaching career as a junior in high school. She made her decision to become a violin teacher early on and was entrusted with the violin students from a former teacher when he moved to go for higher education. While earning her degree at USC, Ms. Chace taught for the University of South Carolina String Project, which is a teacher training program as well as a program that teaches students of all ages how to play orchestral stringed instruments. Ms. Chace's students perform well very frequently and she has had many students go on to win competitions and leadership positions, both in music and in their extra curricular activities.

Beyond playing and teaching, Ms. Chace enjoys teaching skiing during the cool winter months at Belleayre Mountain in Highmount, NY and she's also very passionate about all things related to Disney and traveling. She currently resides in Kingston, NY and many of her violin and viola students are in Ulster and Dutchess Counties and their surrounding cities.
