

# Kingston Catholic School Science Fair

## January 26, 2020



The science fair has been designed to enhance your student's interest in Science. The science fair will allow your children to explore an area of science that relates to the NYS Next Generation Science Standards and interests him or her. The students will develop a sense of confidence in presenting their ideas and learn from all of the projects presented at the fair.

Based on curriculum guidelines, grades 6-8 will be **required** to complete an experiment. All students in grades 6-8 must follow the scientific process and create a display board to present their research (complete details will be discussed and handed out in class.). Each child will follow the project guidelines from their teacher and will be graded on their work. **The science fair will be held on January 26, 2020, beginning at 11:00am** and will be judged by selected community members.

**\*\*In grades PK-5 the science fair is optional. Family participation is accepted and encouraged.**

**\*\*Students in grades PK-5 only, please complete the attached Science Project Entry Form.**

**\*\*Students in grades 6-8, please refer to the directions from your science teachers.**

**Procedure:**

1. Choose a project that is STEM (science, technology, engineering & math) and reflects your interests in science.
2. Create a display board for your project, which should include a title, pictures, charts, diagrams and graphs.
3. Prepare your presentation.
4. Students will be given five minutes to present/demonstrate his/her project to the judges.

**Format (Grades PK-5)**

- 1.a. Select a research project
  - b. Research your topic
2. Identify purpose and procedures
3. Observation and data collection
4. Interpret your data and formulate a conclusion
5. Recommendations (What do your findings mean? Do your findings support scientific laws?)

**Suggestions**

1. Do something that interests you.
2. Make sure you can complete the project within the given time frame.
3. Make sure your project is portable and can be brought to school.
4. Make sure you have access to the materials you will need to complete your project.
5. Make sure it is **safe!**
