Re-enrollment *for* Next School Year

These are unusual, trying times.

All of our daily routines have changed dramatically; and we are sure the last thing on everyone's mind, while trying to juggle everyday life, is re-registration for Kingston Catholic's 2020-2021 School year.

This is just a reminder to please take a minute to go on the TADS website and re-register for school for next year if you have not already done so. The re-registration fee of \$125 per student has been extended until June 1st. After that date, it goes up to \$225 per student.

Transportation Date Extended to May 9, 2020.

If you have filled out a form and sent it to the KCS office, they have been sent to the districts. You do not need to do anything else.

If you have not filled out a transportation form, and need one, there is still time. You can find transportation forms and email addresses for the various districts under Kingston Catholic's website – Family Envelopes – Week of 3 25 20.

If a form is not filled out for the 2020-2021 school year by May 9th, your child may not be able to get a bus to and from school.
